

TH1-TH2 Balance, TH17 und CD69

TH1, TH2 und TH17 Zellen sind Untergruppen der Thymus-Helfer-Zellen.

TH1-Zellen regulieren entzündliche Prozesse.

TH1-Zellen zerstören infizierte Zellen, speziell im Rahmen der Abwehr von Bakterien.

TH17-Zellen chronifizieren Entzündungsprozesse.

TH2-Zellen aktivieren die Abwehr von extrazellulären Krankheitserregern durch allergisch-hyperergischen Reaktionen, die Stimulation von Mastzellen und basophilen und eosinophilen Granulozyten und aktivieren B-Zellen zur Bildung von Antikörpern, der humoralen Abwehr.

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
